Conservation storage, equipment and display specialist Conservation By Design (CXD) has won a £3.3 million contract to supply display showcases for the new Riverside Museum in Glasgow.

The new museum, designed by acclaimed architect Zaha Hadid, will replace the Museum of Transport currently located at the Kelvin Hall. The development will be built adjacent to Glasgow Harbour, where the River Clyde meets Glasgow's other main river, the Kelvin.

CXD will supply over 70 individually designed showcases for the museum, which will house previously unseen exhibits. The museum will use its collection of vehicles and models to tell the story of transport by land and sea, with a unique Glaswegian flavour. More than 3,000 objects will be on display, from the oldest surviving pedal cycle to the finest collection of Scottish-built cars in the world.

Denise Troughton, marketing manager for Conservation By Design, said: "The Riverside Museum is an ambitious project to bring the transport heritage of Glasgow to life.
